A funeral took place the following day and food was saved and prepared for that as well. Some things were frozen and we have used that food to feed volunteer workers this past week. Your many hands have fed more people than you know - God is still multiplying the fish and the loaves! To God be all the glory!

Our prayer is that God will abundantly bless every hand, every person, and every effort that have been made to make our lives more comfortable and our Thanksgiving Day a great celebration day for us!
